A. Purpose

1. The purpose of this directive is to establish when and how players will receive player subsidies.

B. Policy

1. It is the policy of the Brampton Youth Soccer Club to establish guidelines and processes relating to the management of Representative and Houseleague Soccer teams.

C. Definitions

1. For the purposes of this directive, the following definitions shall apply:
 - (a) Rep – means Representative soccer teams, which play competitive soccer representing the city of Brampton.
 - (b) BYSC – means Brampton Youth Soccer Club
 - (c) Houseleague – For the purpose of this directive, houseleague includes all teams from ages 4 to 18 that are not Rep teams.
 - (d) Subsidy – help with expenses, a monetary gift or contribution to somebody or something, pay soccer related expenses, includes permitting to pay fees in installments.
 - (e) Payment Plan / Installment Plan – A credit system by which payment for merchandise is made in installments over a fixed period of time.

D. General

1. Any player, who would like to request club financial assistance or subsidy, shall apply to the BYSC board of directors for approval with the following information:
 - a. Players name and age.
 - b. Name and age of any other players currently training or playing soccer and where they are enrolled.
 - c. Letter from Jumpstart showing approval or rejection of application.
 - d. Reason for need of financial assistance.
2. All subsidy approvals and rejections will be entered into the BYSC Board of Director minutes.
3. No player will be permitted to be placed on a payment plan without written permission of the BYSC Board of Directors.
4. All players' fees are to be paid prior to the player being carded by the club.
